I feel it could be convenient if one could do:</p> <pre>[blabla.model @my/parameter1 val @my/parameter2 val]</pre> <p>I guess I'd mostly use such a workflow to define default values for a particular model, hence I'd need to address only the value attribute of my parameters but I think Théo told me the mechanism would work for all parameters' attributes (not only value)</p>
